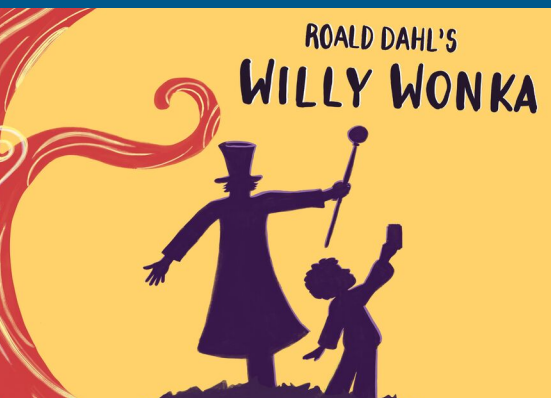

ROALD DAHL'S WILLY WONKA

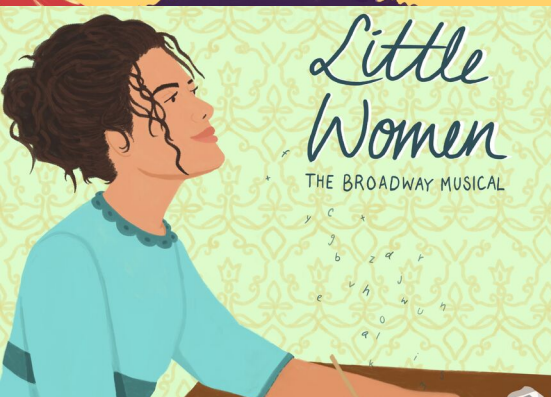

The Little Prince

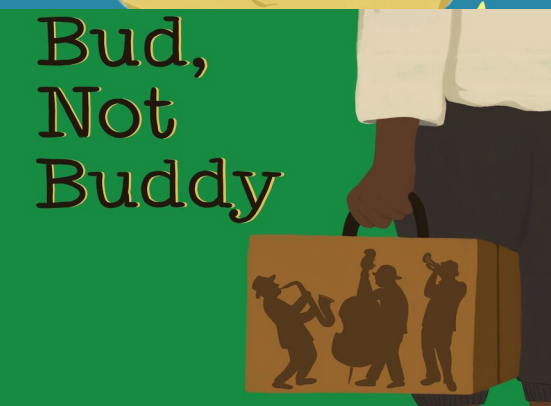
