

WFT@BU is committed to promoting a safe educational environment for students, faculty, and staff in accordance with current state and local public safety guidelines. We are excited to return to in-person programming. In order to do so as safely as possible, all participants in WFT@BU in-person theatre arts classes and rehearsals must follow the following guidelines:

- All students must provide proof of vaccination upon registering for the class. If you wish to request a religious exemption, please contact us at WFTed@bu.edu. All teachers of WFT@BU in-person programming will be vaccinated.
- Masks will be required for all students and faculty in accordance with Boston University's mask policy. [Boston University's Face Covering's policy](#)
- WFT@BU will require all students and staff to complete a symptom monitoring survey prior to each class/rehearsal.
- All participants will be encouraged to wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer throughout the course of the class/rehearsal.
- Class/rehearsal activities will be designed to minimize contact and maximize social distancing to the extent possible.
- Snack breaks/mask breaks will be taken outside whenever possible. When held indoors, strict social distancing will apply.
- Any participant showing symptoms of COVID-19 will be isolated while arrangements are made for them to leave class/rehearsal.
- Any participant who has tested positive for COVID-19 or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive, will need to contact the Director of Education at jerih@bu.edu as soon as possible. We will keep families informed of any potential exposure.
- We will continue to monitor public safety recommendations and be prepared to adjust the structure and nature of our classes and performances as necessary to adhere to current guidelines and regulations.
