Core Responsibilities

- Cost out the scenic designs and suggest alterations to the design to stay within the show's budget.
- Draft build plans
- Create a build schedule
- Assists in recruiting, training, and assigning carpentry and paint staff for individual shows, including orienting them on safety, technical characteristics, and other areas of facility operations.
- Administration of scene shop resources and supplies and ensure the scenic elements stay within the show budget
- Ensure proper functioning, safety, and maintenance of technical equipment
- Ensure the safety of the technical team and staff
- Attend Design, Production Meetings, and technical rehearsals as needed
- Participate in construction, load-in, and strike of scenery
- Work on rigging and automation projects as needed
- Additional duties as assigned/needed

Minimum Requirements

- 4 years of technical directing experience or a degree in technical production
- Physical demands:
 - o Lifting/Carrying 50lbs or more
 - o Work on heights (ladders, catwalks, scissor lifts, and other elevation devices)
- Valid driver's license
- Ability to teach and work with staff and crew of varying experience and skills
- Ability to create, read, and interpret technical drawings
- Drafting program/software knowledge
- Basic knowledge of lighting and sound equipment
- Proficiency in theatrical construction techniques
- Proficiency in construction equipment and tools
- Knowledge of standard and safe rigging practices
- Knowledge of safety equipment and products
- Knowledge of secure handling and disposal of hazardous materials
