

# The Family Conversation Guide

## *Charlotte's Web*

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Stories stay alive when we talk about them.  
Use these questions to spark conversation before the show, during  
intermission, and on the way home.

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### BEFORE THE SHOW

1. What do you think makes someone a truly good friend?
2. Have you ever met an animal that seemed to have its own personality? What was it like?
3. This story includes moments of both joy and saying goodbye. Why do you think stories sometimes include both happy and sad moments?
4. Sometimes characters must be brave to help someone they care about. What does courage look like to you?

### AT INTERMISSION

1. Which character are you most interested in so far? What makes them stand out to you?
2. Wilbur feels worried about what might happen to him. What helps you when you feel worried about something?
3. Charlotte uses words in a clever way to help her friend. Why do you think words can be so powerful?
4. What do you think might happen next? How do you think friendship might help the characters?

### AFTER THE SHOW

1. What made Charlotte and Wilbur such good friends? What did they do for each other?
2. Was there a moment that made you feel especially happy, sad, or hopeful? Why do you think it affected you that way?
3. What is one lesson about friendship, kindness, or courage that you will remember from this story?
4. The actors, costumes, music, and set all helped tell the story. What theatrical moment stood out to you the most?
